### GENERAL PURPOSE

Perform a variety of technical duties for the design and construction of city infrastructure, including roadways, utilities and other capital improvement projects.

### ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Meet performance standards established with the employee's supervisor.

Job attendance is required, except for authorized leave. All or a majority of the essential job duties may be performed from a remote location.

Ability to design and draft plans for engineering projects using AutoCAD under the direct supervision of a professional engineer.

Review engineering drawings to verify compliance with local and state codes.

Review and approve Land Disturbance Permits and Planning Plot Plan reviews associated with the Building Permit process.

Assist with bidding procedure, including preparation of bid documents, meeting with various personnel, and the assembling of bid and contract documents.

Assist with the enforcement of City codes, ordinances, and standards.

Assist in the process of writing and issuing permits.

Perform other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Education and Experience:

A. Graduation from High School or G.E.D., supplemented by college level courses or equivalent vocational/technical institutional coursework in mathematics, engineering and computer aided drafting;

B. Three years of paraprofessional experience performing engineering design and drafting work using AutoCAD software;

Ability to use AutoCAD proficiently.
